CHARITY FUNDRAISING RIDE:

Proposal to replace the usual Saturday Ride on 16th September with a challenge ride, 2 routes - 100 mile & 50. 'Hereward's Hundred and Hereward's Half'. £10 entry ride fee - proceeds from which to be donated to Midlands Air Ambulance in recognition of their valuable service.

Action: Anthony to check with Nigel Worne if Hereward is happy to put his name to the ride. Ant to design the 2 routes and put out postings in advance and closer to.

USE OF CLUB FUNDS:

Whilst club funds are at a healthy amount it was proposed that a donation could be made to charity. This year it is suggested to add to the proceeds from the proposed charity fundraising ride as outlined above for Midlands Air Ambulance. An amount of £200 was suggested. This will be finalised and actioned at the next committee meeting on October 18th.

It was agreed that club funds can be used to pay for first aid training for some of the regular riders from the A, B and C groups. Jon and Tim who ride regularly in the A group will source training for themselves which the club funds will reimburse them for. Marie will put out a posting to see if anyone else from the other groups are either already first aid trained or are willing to become so. (Presently both Jacqui Kinch & Marie are first aid qualified).

Action: Jon, Tim, Marie

Proposal to book a coaching session at Darley Moor, ideally a 1 - 2 hour slot on a Saturday morning. To be offered to all members and prospective new members who would benefit from practicing group riding skills, personal bike handling skills & road awareness training. Marie will make enquiries to cycle coaches Kate Samways and Steve Green as well as enquiring when a slot at Darley Moor track is available. Club funds would cover the cost of the coach and hire of Darley Moor track. **Action: Marie**

AOB:

Proposal to put club banner on fence opposite Sainsburys entrance at traffic lights.

Council needs to be checked with first.

Action: Mark

Proposal to gauge interest in running Monday evening beginner rides in 2018. This would be dependent upon there being enough club members to help run these. Idea being a course of 6-8 sessions running in May/June/July. Posting to go out in Feb/March 2018 to see if enough volunteers are willing to commit.
